There has been so much to celebrate as a school! The **phonics screening** was the focus for Year 1 – they did brilliantly and their result will be shared in their end of year report. Year Two children have been doing the **KS1 SATs** together – these are non-statutory this year but so helpful for the team when thinking about what the children need to work on as they progress into Key Stage 2 in a few weeks time. They all did so well and should be so proud of themselves, I certainly am!
