Both are full time positions, 30 hours per week, term time only, on Scale 3 (£18,657 - £19,623 pro rata).

What does the role involve?

When working with a specific child the successful candidate will be required to demonstrate experience in:

- Establishing a supportive relationship with the named child,
- Taking into account the learning support required, to aid the child to engage with their learning as effectively as possible both in group situations and on his/her own,
- To assist, with the class teacher (and other professionals as appropriate), in the implementation of directed programmes of support
- Have the highest expectation that every pupil will make sustained academic and personal progress
- Assisting the named child with their educational and social development, on an individual and group basis

- Providing expertise to deliver a personalised curriculum for each pupil's learning

We are looking for colleagues who:

- Have high expectations of themselves and the care of pupils
- Are committed to achieving the highest outcomes for all children
- Will contribute to the positive ethos of the school
- Have a flexible attitude and a genuine passion to change children's lives by inspiring them to reach and exceed their social and academic potential
